Spokane International Academy, OID # 21-30A Claire Petersky: The proposed issuance of one or more series of tax-exempt and taxable revenue bonds to: (1) finance and refinance the acquisition, construction, improvement, furnishing, equipping and rehabilitation of certain land and the Facilities; (2) fund any required reserves; (3) fund capitalized interest and/or related working capital with respect to the Bonds, if necessary; and (4) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. Georgetown Community Development Authority Projects, OID # 20-97A Claire Petersky: The proposed issuance of one or more series of tax-exempt revenue bonds to finance: (i) capital costs of the Projects; (ii) funding a debt service reserve fund for the Bonds; (iii) working capital related to the Projects; (iv) capitalized interest on the Bonds; and (v) a portion of the costs of issuing the Bonds. Project 1 is located at 6520 5th Avenue S., 500 S. River Street and 6555 5th Avenue S., Seattle, WA 98108; Project 2 is located at 402 - 416 S. Lucile Street, Seattle, WA 98108 and Project 3 is located at 404 S.

Brandon Street, Seattle, WA 98108. The projects are owned by Equinox Studios COG, a Washington 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation. The total estimated bond amount is not expected to exceed \$36,500,000. (10 min.)
