WASHINGTON STATE HOUSING FINANCE COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

October 1, 2021

A public hearing was opened remotely for OID# 15-57A, Dawson Place Child Advocacy Center at 10:20 a.m., Friday, October 1, 2021, per the Governor's proclamation regarding the Open Public Meetings Act and Public Records Act (Proclamation 20-28) and due to extraordinary public-health circumstances related to the ongoing COVID-19 (coronavirus) outbreak.

Ms. Claire Petersky, Manager, Multifamily Housing and Community Facilities Division of the Washington State Housing Finance Commission (the "Commission"), stated that this is a public hearing for the purpose of considering a plan of finance for the reissuance by the Commission of a tax-exempt revenue bond (the "Bond") originally issued to provide a portion of the funds to refinance a facility located at 1509 California Street, Everett, WA 98201, owned by Child Advocacy Center of Snohomish County at Dawson Place dba Dawson Place, a Washington nonprofit corporation described under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Bond may be issued as one or more series issued from time to time and may include series of refunding

Proceeds of the reissued Bond will refinance existing debt originally used for the acquisition of and capital improvements to the Dawson Place Child Advocacy Center in Everett, WA. Maximum Reissued Bond Amount is not expected to exceed \$1,350,000.

Ms. Petersky then opened the hearing to comments from the public. After hearing no comments, Ms. Petersky closed the public hearing at 10:25 a.m.
