Re: Outcome: better coordination with public funding

This group is gathered to help the WSHFC develop policy that will produce **better coordination with other public funders**. Objectives include:

- 1. Alignment with other public entities' goals
- 2. More efficient use of public funds

The public funders up for consideration:

- 1. Washington State Housing Trust Fund
- 2. Sound Transit a separate set-aside, or in the mix? (and are there other TOD programs that we don't know about?)
- 3. City or county funding including coalitions of funders such as ARCH
- 4. Others?

Assume \$500 million total available - how much for this outcome? Is this an overlay on other categories, or a set-aside of bond cap? Percentage of overlay/ amount of set-aside?

Additional policies we may want to apply:

- Maybe as thresholds, or for points:
 - 1. Minimum set-asides
 - 2. Special populations
 - 3. Cost efficiency measures
 - 4. Community Revitalization (as required in law)

Other issues:

- Not count direct appropriation from the state or earmarks from the federal government – we do not want to incentive a political process to get access to bond cap
- 2. Public funding for any non-housing portion of the project should it count or not?
