WASHINGTON STATE HOUSING FINANCE COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

November 16, 2018

A public hearing was opened on The Adriana Senior Apartments, OID No. 15-62A, at 9:03 a.m., Friday, November 16, 2018 in the 28th Floor Elliott Bay Room of the Commission's offices located at 1000 Second Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98104–3601.

Ms. Valeri Pate, AMC Director of Washington State Housing Finance Commission, stated that this is a hearing for the proposed issuance of one or more series of tax—exempt revenue obligations (the "Notes") to refinance a tax—exempt revenue obligation used to finance a portion of the costs for the acquisition and construction of a senior housing facility located at 22525 7th Avenue South, Des Moines, WA 98198 to be owned by The Adriana Senior Apartments, LLLP, a Washington limited liability limited partnership.

Proceeds of the Note will be used to refinance a portion of the financing for the acquisition of land and new construction and equipping of a 119-unit senior housing facility in Des Moines, WA. Each apartment is a complete and separate dwelling unit consisting of living, eating and sanitation facilities. A percentage of the total units are set aside for persons or households with low incomes. The total estimated facility cost will be approximately \$19,724,147 and the estimated aggregate amount of the Notes is not expected to exceed \$15,000,000.

Ms. Pate asked if there were any comments. After hearing none, the public hearing was closed at 9:13 a.m.
